

# Poor Housekeeping is the No.1 cause for workplace accidents

### To avoid incidents

You must maintain an orderly workplace throughout the day to remove hazards and prevent injury.

Uncontrolled scaffold material, tools, clutter or spills cause accidents and are NOT accepted on the work-site.





# **Take Actions to Prevent Dropped Object Incidents**

### ✓ Effective Housekeeping:

A good housekeeping program identifies and assigns responsibilities for the following:

- · Clean up during and after the shift.
- Dispose of waste correctly.
- Removal of unused materials and store correctly.
- · Inspection to ensure clean-up is complete.

### ✓ Housekeeping on Scaffold Platforms:

Protection against falling materials from scaffold structures can be prevented by several control measure including:

- Installation of debris netting.
- Installation of brick / zip guards and / or scaffold fans as appropriate.
- Installation of toe-boards.
- · Clearing unused material to suitable laydown areas.

### ✓ Clean scaffold platforms prior to dismantle

The build-up of construction waste can cause falling materials from scaffold structures during maintenance and / or prior to dismantle. Housekeeping is an integral part of the dismantle phase enhanced by several control measure including:

- Housekeeping during construction works by the contractor i.e. scaffolders, brick layers, carpenters, painters, roofers etc.
- · Cleaning of the working platform by the customer / end-user prior to dismantle works.
- · Removal of debris from in and around the scaffold structure to ensure clear access & egress with material.
